

Isabelia pulchella

The *Isobelia* genus contains 5 species found growing as epiphytes in the humid forests of Brazil.

They form mats and have closely spaced pseudobulbs surrounded by a fibrous network.

These species may be grown on slabs or in shallow pots under intermediate conditions.
